Sunliner quality and luxury now available in 2 new Caravan Series

Sunliner Recreational Vehicles have been manufacturing campervans and motorhomes for over 30 years and are now proud to add **caravans** to their extensive range, making them one of only three Australian RV manufacturers to offer diversified RV range. Sunliner General Manager, Nick Hunter explains Sunliner's move in to the caravan market "We have been studying the Australian towable market for a few years and believed there was a niche in the Australian RV Industry for a lightweight, well built Australian made caravan. There seemed to be a lot of the same vans out there, and we thought we could bring something new to the market."

In the design process Sunliner analysed their most popular motorhome layouts and realised that they could work just as well as a caravan. Sunliner's construction technique has been proven in their motorhomes for over 30 years and are very confident the caravans will hold up extremely well. "We have used our ThermoTough fibreglass wall construction on these vehicles allowing them to be fully insulated and extremely strong." Sunliner have also used the features from Europe, including the AL-KO tow hitch and independent suspension, however have incorporated it with an Australian made chassis.

There will be 4 caravan Series in the Sunliner caravan range. The first two Series to be released, are the Holiday and Provincial Series. The Holiday Series is the entry level product in the Sunliner caravan range. Standard with electric entry step, side awning, TV/DVD combination, CD player, oven & grill, innerspring mattress, 100 amp hr battery. "Even with all of these features, the first van in this range astounded us when at 16'9" weighed in at 1300 kgs."

The Provincial Series is the top of the range caravan on offer from Sunliner and exudes total luxury and is highly appointed; leather, hardwood trims and full fibreglass mouldings. Again this van is extremely light; weighing in under 2000 kgs at 21ft. "This range highlights Sunliner's quality and workmanship. We have also included some of our more innovative designs including electric drop down beds and electric slide out modules. All very exciting and very new to the caravan market."

There will be another two Series released later in the year; one of which will be designed for families.

Sunliner have not yet finalised the distribution channels for the caravan range. Currently the Sunliner caravans can be seen at Melbourne RV Centre, however Sunliner are currently taking expressions of interest from other caravan dealers.
